APPOINTMENT OF THE DEAN OF THE FACULTY OF ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES

1.0 OBJECTIVE

- 1.1 This Circular seeks to inform all staff of the Cyberjaya University College of Medical Sciences on a new appointment of the Dean of the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences.

2.0 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Since the establishment of the University, CUCMS has only offered two undergraduate courses and one foundation programme. The courses are Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Pharmacy (Honours) and Foundation in Science (Medicine / Pharmacy).
- 2.2 In 2009, CUCMS introduced one more new course under the Faculty of Traditional & Complementary Medicine. The course is Bachelor of Homeopathic Medical Science (Honours).
- 2.3 The University is always driven to offer more health care courses in the future. This aligns with the mission and vision of the University. Due to that, in 2010, the university took a step forward by establishing the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences.

3.0 DECISION

In the last Senate meeting No.21 dated 25 March 2010, has approved the establishment of Faculty of Allied Health Sciences. According to the CUCMS Constitution Part IV – Authorities of the University College Section 18 (4) states, "The Chief Executive, after consultation with the academic staff of each Faculty, shall appoint a Dean in respect of each Faculty and at least one Deputy Dean."


